

James Frisbie Award

From 1966 until his retirement at the end of the 1999 school year, James Frisbie taught in the Dakota school district. After graduating from Freeport High School in 1962, Mr. Frisbie attended Freeport Community College, which later became Highland Community College. He is very proud to have been in the first graduating class at Highland in 1964. Mr. Frisbie believed that Highland was a tremendous opportunity for him and has instituted this scholarship program to aide graduating Dakota seniors who wish to further their education by going to Highland Community College as he did. Mr. Frisbie passed away in 2019 but in his will requested that his scholarship continue and has been generously funded by his estate.

Amount: (4) \$1000 scholarships (2 males, 2 Female)

Eligibility: The scholarship will be for graduating seniors from Dakota High School; Recipients must plan on attending HCC and must have a minimum GPA of 2.5; **graduating seniors who finish in the top ten 10% of their class are not eligible as HCC already provides a scholarship to those students.**

Payment: Funds are for educational related expenses such as tuition and books. Payment will be made directly to the students upon written verification of the first semester's tuition payment. The funds must be used during the first two college semesters following the recipient's high school graduation.
