

Lake Summerset Fish Club Scholarship

The Lake Summerset Fish Club Scholarship will award \$500 to a Dakota High School Senior Graduating Spring 2005.

This scholarship is for students who are pursuing advanced degrees in Conservation, Biology, Marine Biology or a closely related field. This scholarship will be given by the Lake Summerset Fish Club. This scholarship can be used for tuition, College living expenses, and other costs directly related to the student's educational expenses. The scholarship will be given directly to the student.

Scholarship Criteria:

Applicant must be on track to graduate from Durand High School in May 2005.

Must be enrolling in a Conservation, Biology, Marine Biology or closely related program.

Applicant must use the scholarship the academic year following graduation. This scholarship is a one-time gift.

Essay on what your plan is after high school and the relationship of the scholarship to your educational goals. Quality and content of student's essay will be a factor in choosing the scholarship recipient.

Application and essay must be submitted to Mr. Kevin Cline by the end of the school day on April 8th. The application and essay will then be submitted to the Lake Summerset Fish Club for review.

Money will be issued upon verification of enrollment and class schedule.
